- **Be inspired** by the potential of a career in the digital/tech space and the broad range of opportunities aligned to their interests that they could pursue.
- **Practise** applying both digital and human-centric skills in real-world challenges.

Part 3 11:30- 12:00	<ul> <li>Explore         exciting new         technology</li> <li>Start the         innovation         challenge!</li> </ul>	Students will get a taste of new technology at the heart of BT Group and its customers as we watch a video tour or 'Aurora,' BT's flagship Customer Experience Centre. This leads into the innovation challenge, pitched as if their manager has tasked students with this. It's a chance to start using the skills we've been highlighting in the session and is an activity to complete after the bootcamp.
