Products over 28 days old from the date of purchase may be replaced with a refurbished or repaired product.

- proof of purchase is required
- the equipment is returned to BT or its agent as instructed.

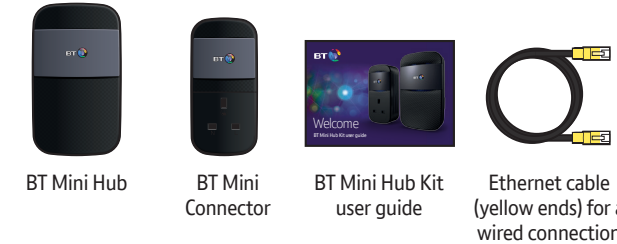
BT Mini Hub 11ac Wi-Fi Home Hotspot Plus 1000 Multi Kit

Please note: this over carton contains 2 gift boxes, the Mini Hub Kit and the Mini Hub add on. The instruction leaflet on the inside of this over carton will explain how to use all 3 devices in conjunction with each other. However full device information can be found on the user guides within the individual boxes.

Important information before you start: before you attempt to install all 3 devices you must be aware that these devices must be paired in order to work in conjunction with each other. The guidelines below will explain how to do this and in what specific order. The other important consideration is to follow the guide lines in relation to the length of time advised when pressing down the **+** button as this is vital to the success of installation.

WARNING: if you press the **+** button for 15 seconds or more you will reset the device, this means it will not pair or it will loose connection with your other broadband devices. You may want to time yourself on a stop watch.

What's in the Mini Hub Kit?



What's in the Mini Hub add on?



Connect the Mini Connector

- 1 Plug one end of the Ethernet cable into any Ethernet port on your router
- 2 Plug the other end into one of the Ethernet ports on top of your Mini Connector
- 3 Plug the Mini Connector directly into a power socket on the wall and switch on.



Plug in the Mini Hub

- 1 For the Mini Hub use a power socket close to your mini connector, (this will be for set up purposes, you can move it once its paired with the mini connector), and power on device.
- 2 The blue power light will come on first followed within 2 minutes by the wireless and data lights.



Now to set up the BT Mini Hub add on

- 1 To set up the Mini Hub to pair with your Hub Multi Kit, plug the Mini Hub add on into a wall socket close to your existing Hub and power it on, (you can then move it once the extra Hub has paired with the existing Hub). The blue power light will come on first, followed by the wireless and data lights.
- 2 Press and hold **+** on the top of the Mini Hub for 5 to 8 seconds, until the power light flashes off and on once more.
- 3 Press **+** again, this time for 1 second. The power light should start flashing.
- 4 **WITHIN 2 MINUTES** press **+** on either the Mini Connector or Mini Hub (from the Multi Kit), for 1 second.
- 5 Wait for a bit for the new Mini Hub to connect. If everything is ok, it's data light will come on too.

Connect your devices

You'll need your Mini Hub's wireless network name and password, found on the settings card on the rear of the Hub. If your device supports WPS, just press **WPS** on your Mini Hub. It's a quick way to connect.



Know your networks

The Mini Hub is dual-band, so you'll see 2 network names on the card, one for the 2.4ghz and 1 for the 5ghz band. The wireless password will be the same for both.
