

## Your BT Graphite 1100 is now ready for use.

**ⓘ** If you ever need to remove the batteries, simply slide open the battery compartment cover and using the finger grip the batteries and pull them out.

- Place handset on the charger to charge for 24 hours.
- Activate batteries as explained above.
- Activate the batteries by pulling the plastic tab away from the back of the handset.

### Set up your additional handsets (multi-packs only)

**ⓘ** Important: Charge the handset batteries for 24 hours or your phone may not work.

- Activate the batteries by pulling the plastic tab away from the back of the handset.
- Place handset on base to charge.
- After 24 hours, plug the telephone line cord into the telephone wall socket.

Products over 28 days old from the date of purchase may be replaced with a refurbished or repaired product.

The conditions of this guarantee are:

- The guarantee shall only apply to defects that occur within the 12 month guarantee period.
- Proof of purchase is required.
- The equipment is returned to BT or its agent as instructed.

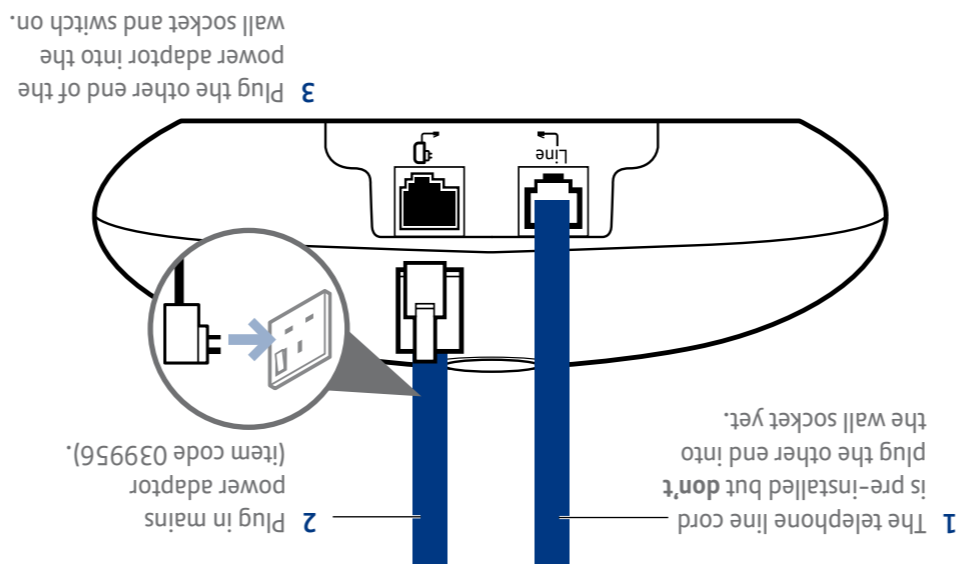

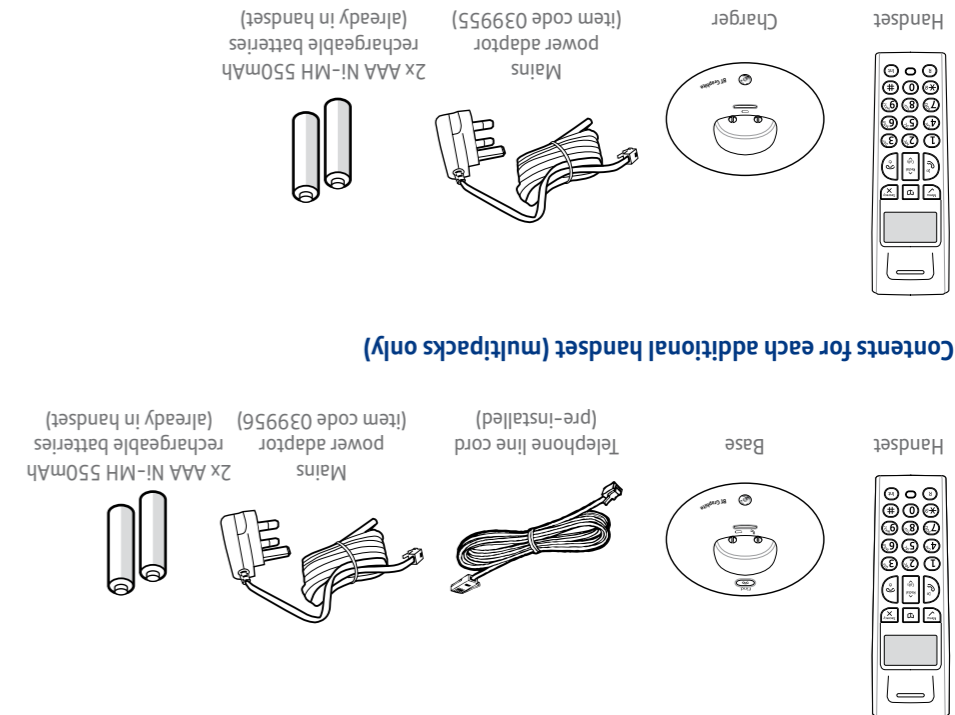

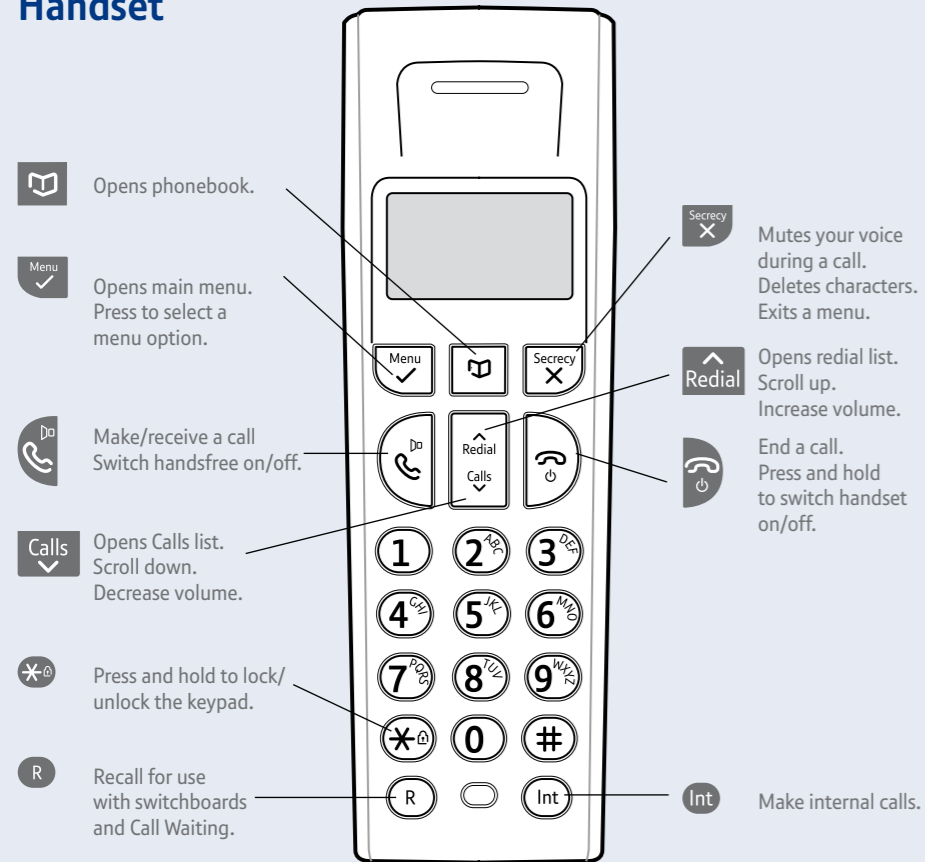

## Navigating the menus

Press **Menu** to enter the main menu.

Press **Redial** and **Calls** buttons to scroll through the menu options (when you reach the end of the list, the first option is displayed again). Press **Menu** to select an option, or press **Secrecy** to return to the previous menu.

To exit a menu and return to standby press **Secrecy** repeatedly.

Some menus are accessed by pressing the relevant feature button:

Press **Menu** to access the phonebook.

Press **Redial** to access the redial list.

Press **Calls** to access the calls list.

## 3 Go!

### Set date and time

Press **Menu**, scroll **Calls** to CLOCK/ALARM, press **Menu**. DATE/TIME is displayed, press **Menu**. Enter date in format (DD/MM), press **Menu**. If you make a mistake, press **Secrecy** to delete. Enter time in 24 hour format, press **Menu** to confirm.

If you have subscribed to a Caller Display service, the time will be set automatically when you receive your first call.

### Making calls

Press **Do** then dial the phone number. Press **Do** to end the call.

### Answering calls

If you have subscribed to Caller Display, the caller's details will be displayed before you answer (see below and also the full user guide online at [www.bt.com/producthelp](http://www.bt.com/producthelp) for details).

Lift the handset from the base or charger to answer incoming calls. If the handset is not on the base or charger, press **Do**.

### Handsfree

Press **Do** during a call to switch between earpiece and loudspeaker.

### Secrecy

During a call, press **Secrecy**. MUTE is displayed and your caller cannot hear you. Press **Secrecy** to resume your call.

### Redial

Press **Redial**, then scroll **Redial** or **Calls** to choose the number you want from the last 10 dialled numbers.

Press **Do** to redial the number.

### Phonebook

#### Storing new phonebook entries (up to 50 entries)

Press **Menu**. PHONEBOOK is displayed, press **Menu**.

If entries already stored the first entry will be displayed, you'll need to press **Menu** again. Otherwise display shows ADD ENTRY. Press **Menu**.

Display shows ADD NAME. Using the letters on the keypad, enter the name. You may need to press the same button a few times until the letter you want is displayed. For example, press **2** once for A, or twice for B. Press **Menu**.

Display shows ADD NUMBER. Enter the phone number and press **Menu** to confirm.

#### Dialling a phonebook entry

Press **Menu**. Scroll **Calls** to the entry you want and press **Do** to dial.

### Caller Display and the Calls list

If you must subscribe to a Caller Display service for this feature to work. Your network provider may charge you for this service.

#### View and dial from the Calls list

Press **Calls**, then **Redial** or **Calls** to scroll through the last 40 incoming calls.

Press **#** repeatedly to switch between the number and date/time of the call.

Press **Do** to dial entry displayed.

Press **Menu** for further options.

## Call Waiting

You must subscribe to a Call Waiting service for this feature to work. Your network provider may charge you for this service.

During a call, if another caller tries to reach you, you will hear a soft beep every 5 seconds.

To speak to the second caller, press **R**, your current caller will be put on hold. Press **R** to switch between both callers.

Or, press **Do** to end the current call. The handset will ring, press **Do** to connect to the waiting caller.

## Ringer volume and melody

### Change handset or base ringer volume (5 levels or off)

Press **Menu**, scroll **Calls** to SETTINGS. Press **Menu**, HANDSET TONE displayed, press **Menu** or scroll **Calls** to BASE TONES and press **Menu**.

RING VOLUME is displayed, press **Menu**. Press **Redial** or **Calls** to select required volume, press **Menu** to confirm.

### Change handset or base ringer melody

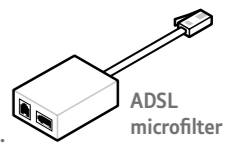
Press **Menu**, scroll **Calls** to SETTINGS. Press **Menu**, HANDSET TONE displayed, press **Menu** or scroll **Calls** to BASE TONES and press **Menu**.

Scroll **Calls** to RING MELODY, press **Menu**. Press **Redial** or **Calls** to select required melody, press **Menu** to confirm.

## Help

Most problems can be fixed with a few simple checks.

Problem	Solution
No dial tone	Only use the cables and batteries supplied. Make sure both the mains power adaptor cable and telephone line cord are plugged into the correct sockets.
Poor speech quality	Make sure the product is not located too close to other electrical appliances. This can also help improve the handset range from the base.
Battery icon not full/handset dead	Make sure you charge the batteries for 24 hours before use to ensure maximum battery performance.
Using broadband on the same phone line?	Make sure you plug the phone into the wall socket via an ADSL microfilter (not supplied), otherwise you may have problems with this product and your broadband service.
