



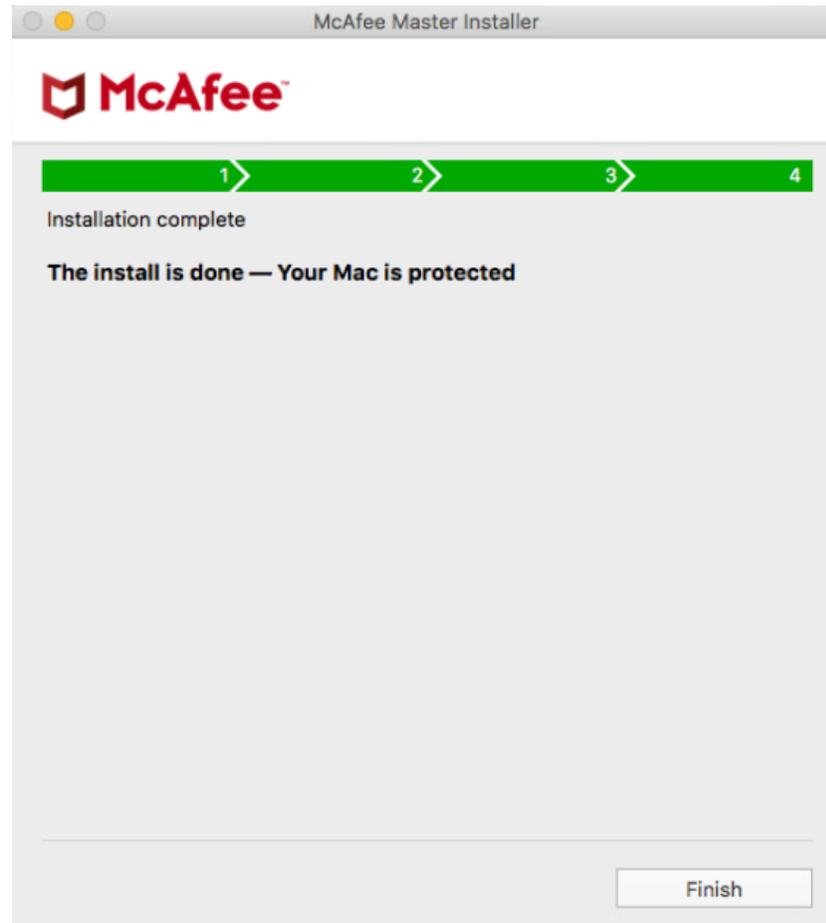
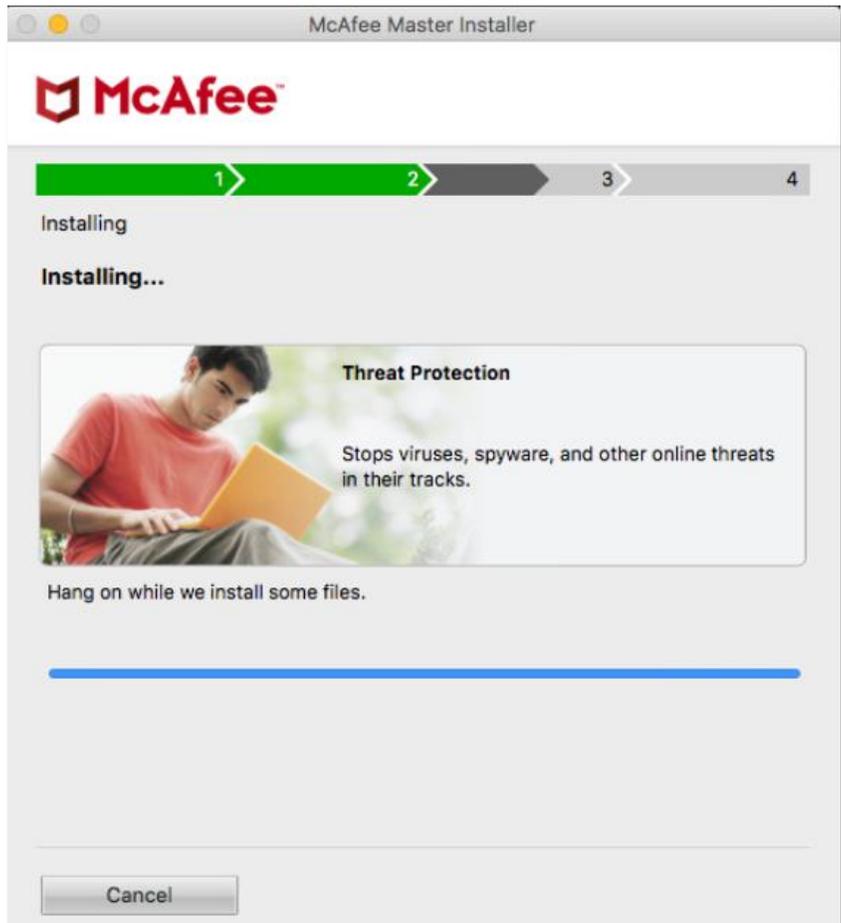

# Mac Hard Block Issue: Experience When Installing Norton Security Software over Existing McAfee Software

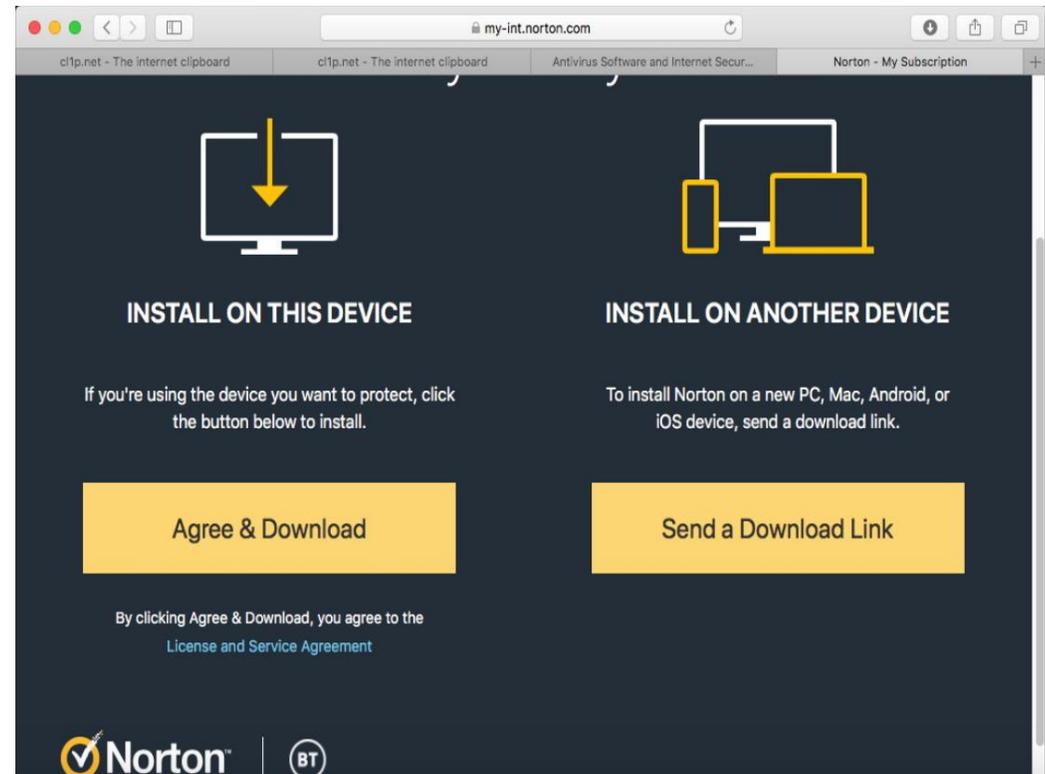
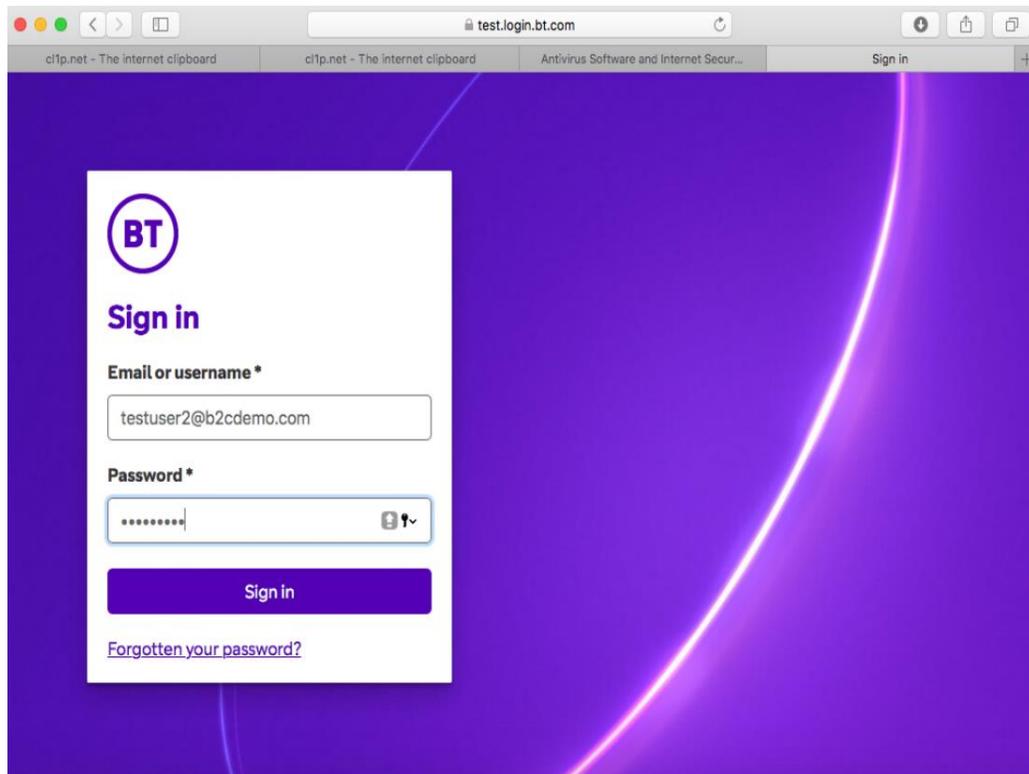

# Step 1 – McAfee's BT Security Installed on Mac

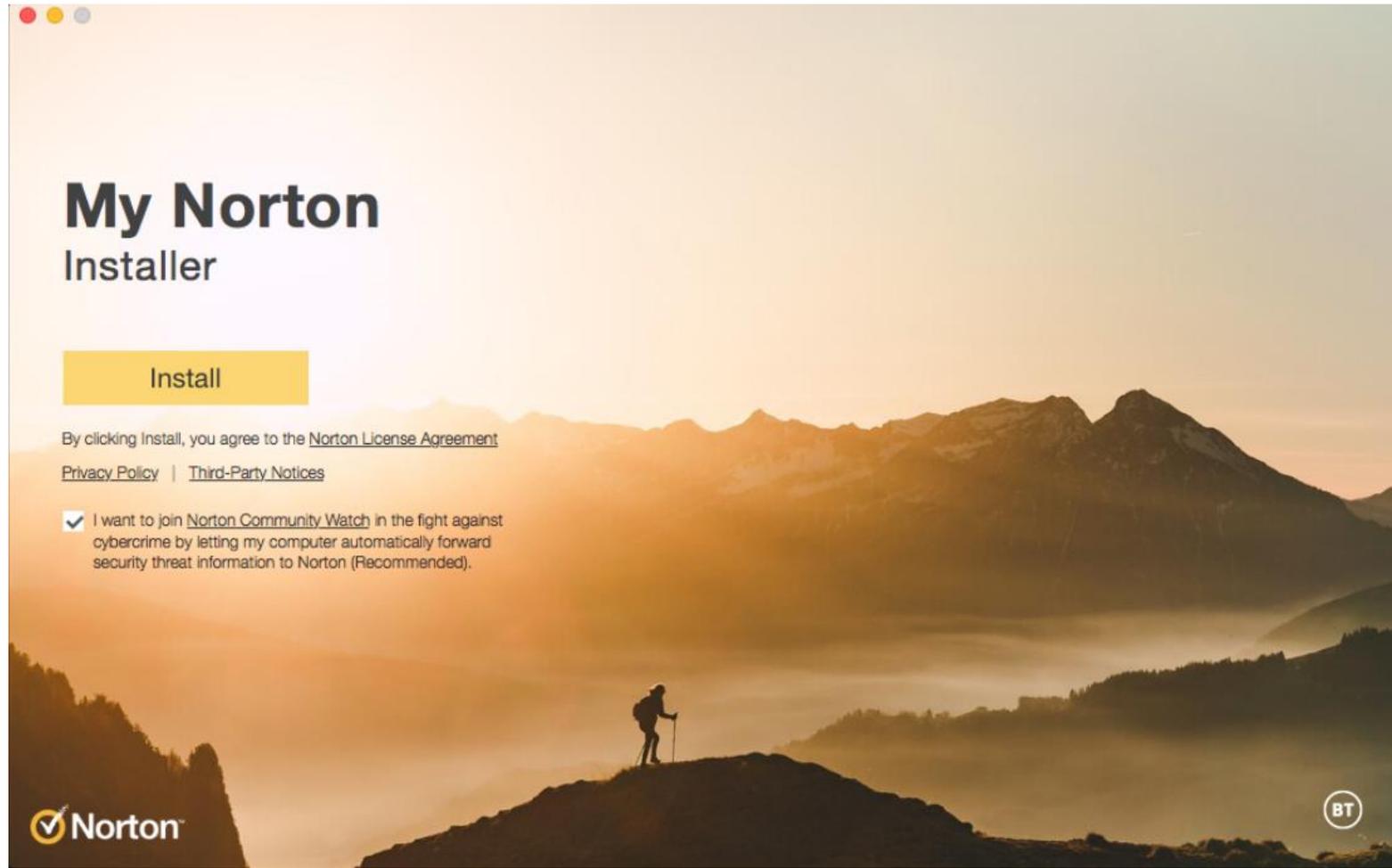


# Step 2 – Get Norton Security Entitlement From BT.com & Initiate the Norton Security Software Download

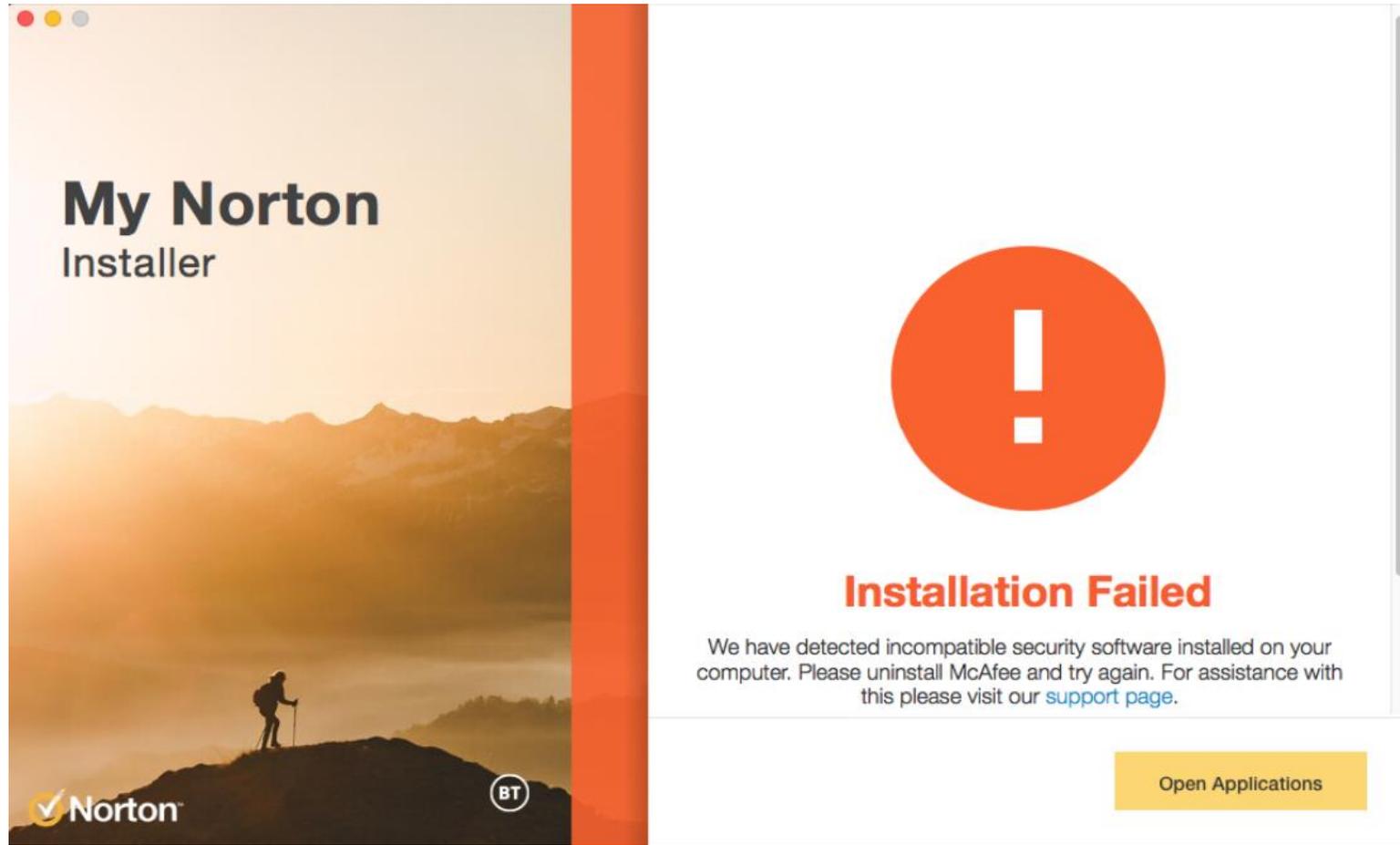
Go to BT.com > sign in with your user credentials to access or get the BT Virus Protect (Norton version) entitlement. Then initiate the Norton Security software download.



# Step 3 – View & Initiate the Install of the Norton Software

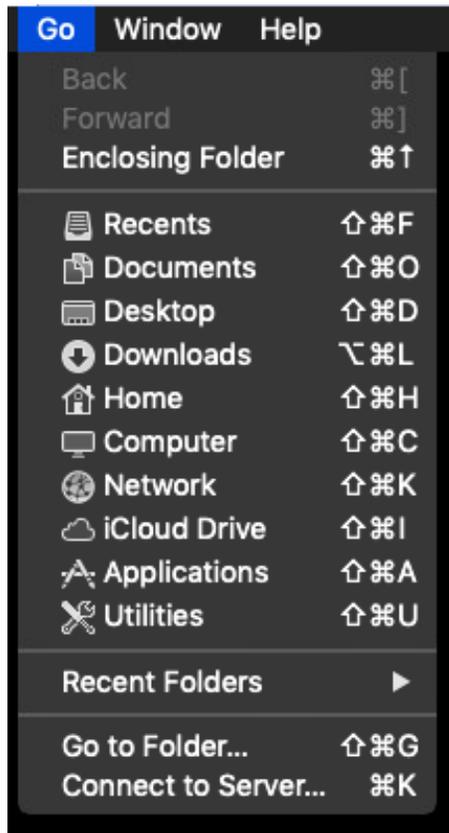


# Step 4 – View the Hard Block Screen Seen on MacOS 10.14 or Below



# Step 5 – Locate the McAfee Uninstaller Listed under ‘Applications’ on Your Mac

To open the list of apps, tap anywhere on the desktop > click on ‘Go’ > Choose ‘Applications.’



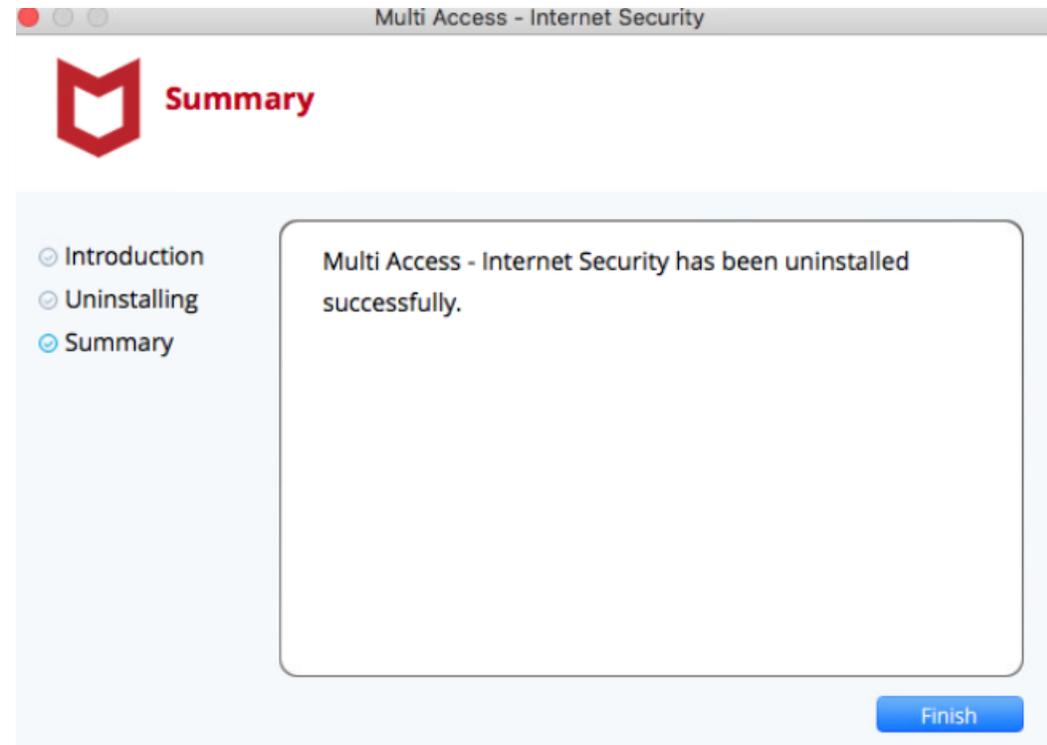
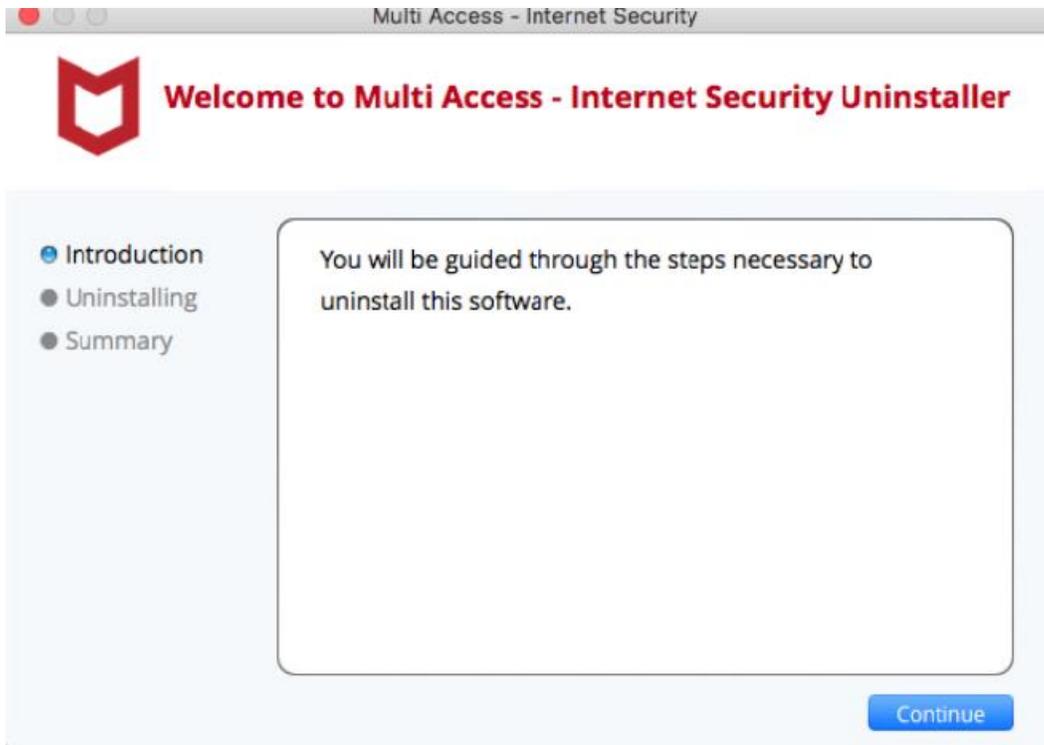
# Step 6 – Initiate the McAfee Uninstaller (Upon Clicking ‘Application’)

Under the list of Applications, identify ‘McAfee Multi Access Uninstaller’ and open it.

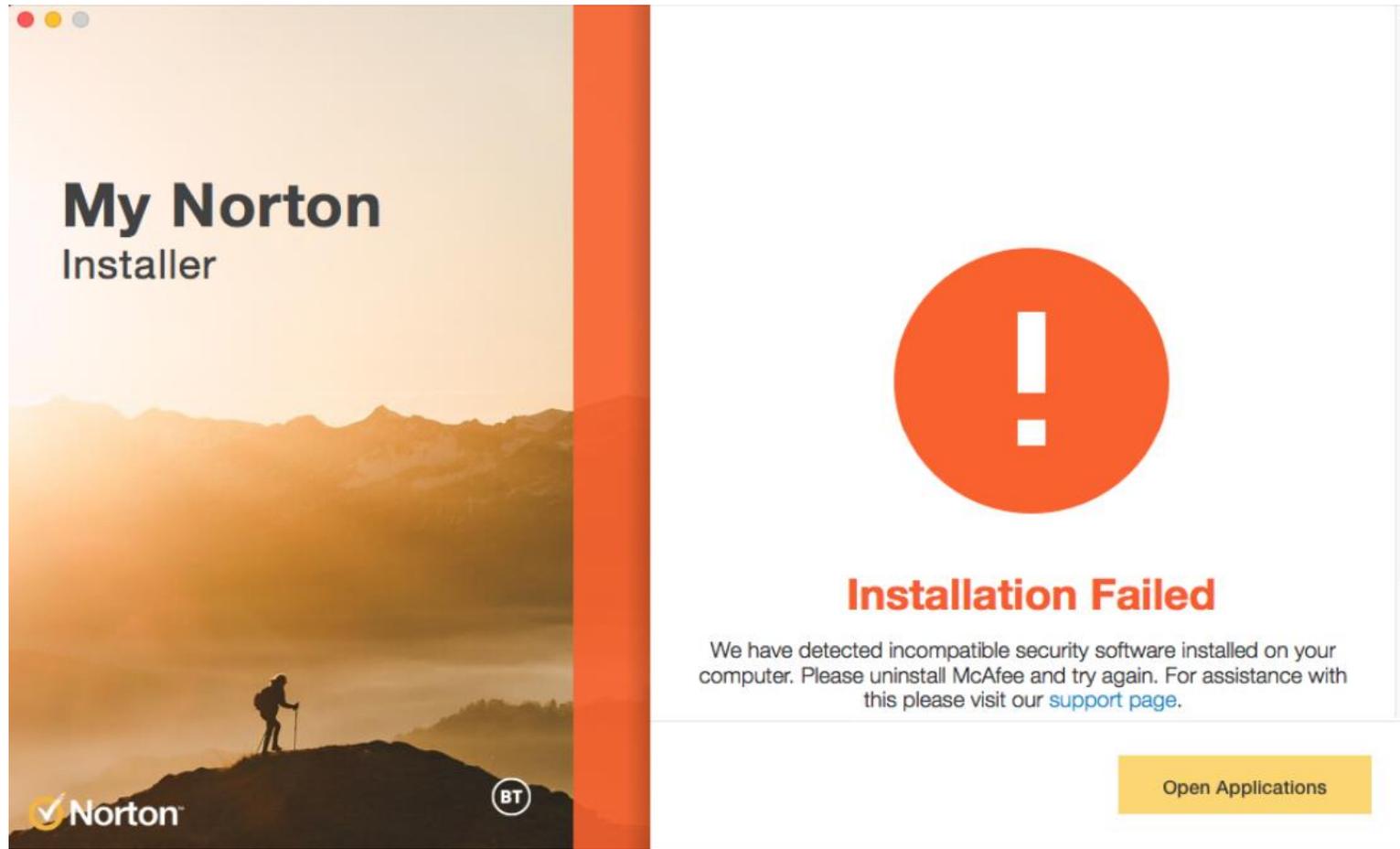


# Step 6 (Cont.) – Follow these Steps to Uninstall the McAfee Software

Once launched, click on 'Continue' to allow the tool to uninstall the McAfee software from your computer.



# Step 7 – Return to the Norton Install Screen; Hard Block Is Still Seen Due to Unresolved McAfee File Traces



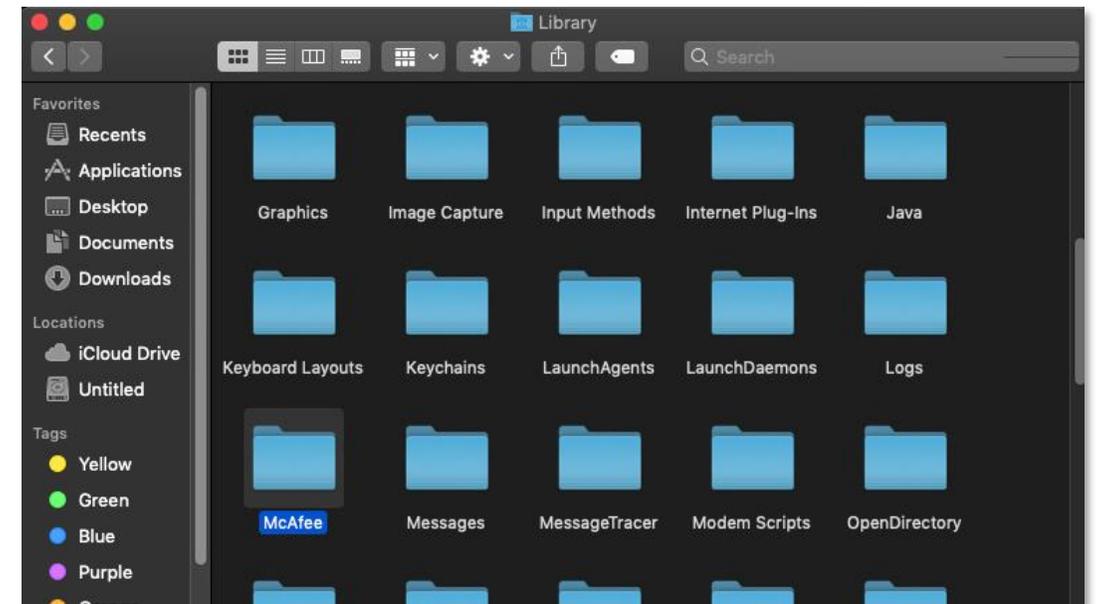
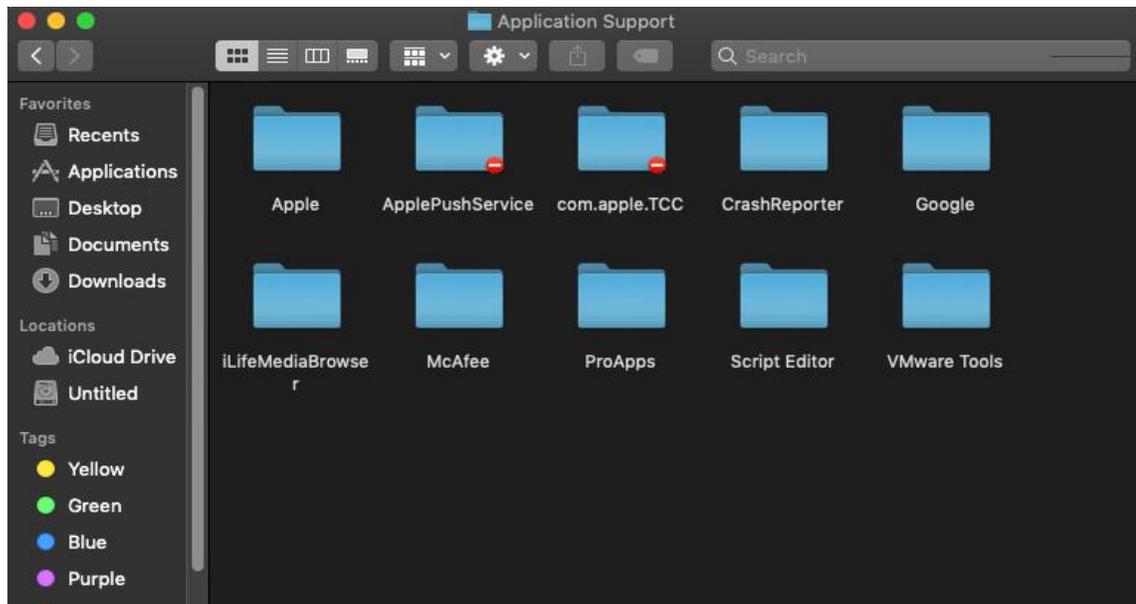
Even though the McAfee software has been removed, remnants of McAfee remain that prevent Norton Security from being installed on the same device.

In such a case, the user is expected to manually locate the file remnants and delete them.

# Step 8 – Locate the McAfee File Remnants Blocking the Install of the Norton Security Software

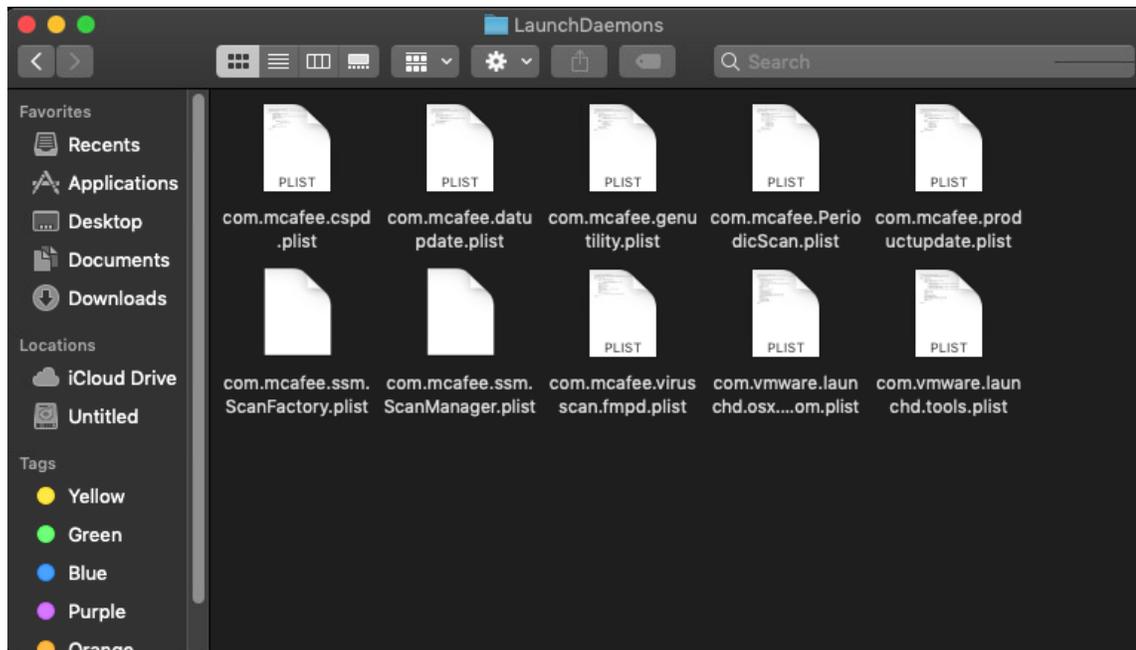
Go > Applications > Application Support > McAfee > Trash the Folder.

Go > Computer > Library > McAfee > Trash the Folder.



# Step 8 (Cont.) – Locate the McAfee File Remnants Blocking the Install of the Norton Security Software

Go > Computer > Library > LaunchDaemons > Type 'McAfee' in the Search Bar > Trash all found Files.

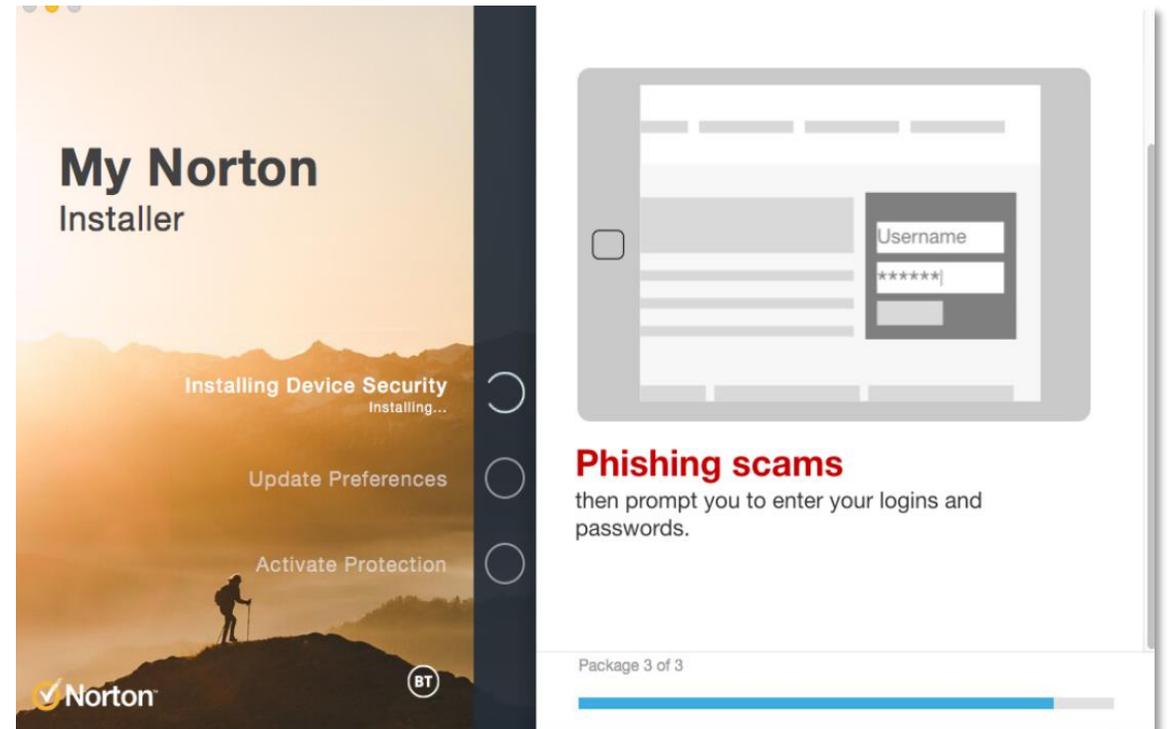
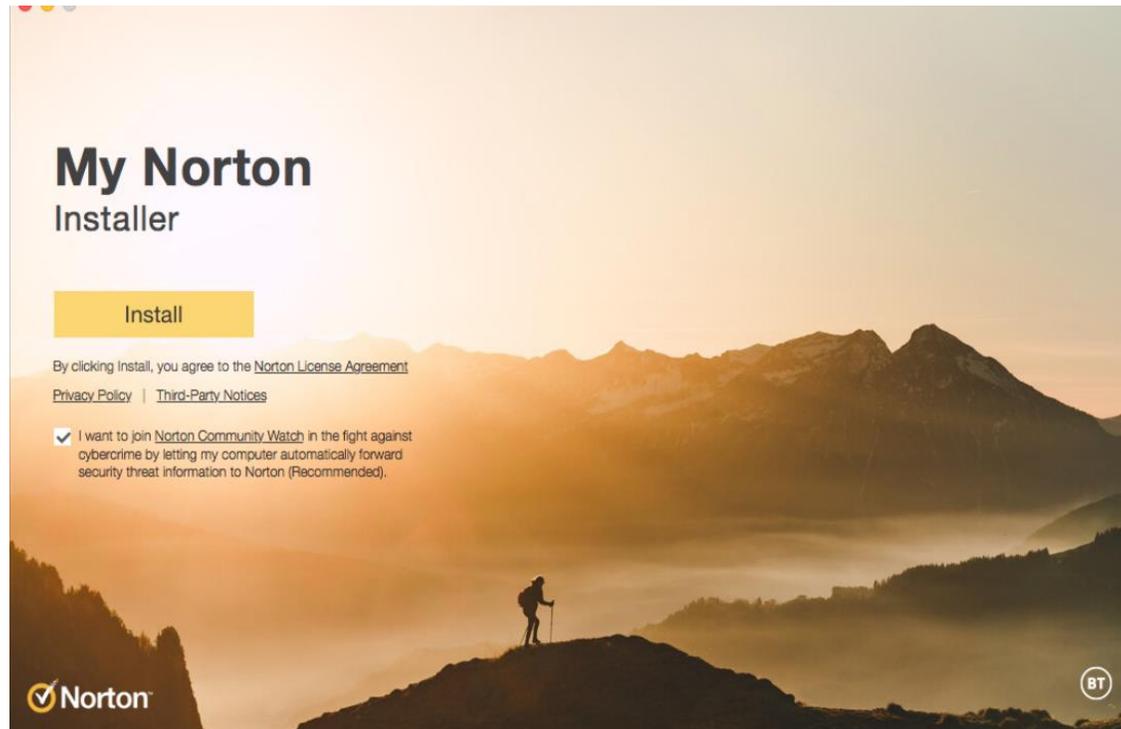


Go > Computer > Library > PreferencePanels > Type 'McAfee' in the Search Bar > Trash all found Files.

Go > Computer > Library > LaunchAgents > Type 'McAfee' in the Search Bar > Trash all found Files.

Last Step: Empty the Trash > Perform a System Restart.
